Method for Determining Fair Market Value of Donated Wine

Wine Appraisals are based on the guidelines of Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) which are as follows:

1. The Canadian retail price is deemed the Fair Market Value for wine generally available and sold in Canada. The term “generally available” denotes that the customer may buy as little or as much as required with no limits or restrictions.

2. If the wine is not generally available for sale in Canada, then said wine may be sourced from reputable retailers worldwide, providing that the wine is in the inventory and available for sale. If the wine is not available for sale on the retail market, then values from current Commercial Auctions worldwide may be used. The source price must then be converted to Canadian currency adding the relevant duties, taxes, transportation and LCBO markup. From this then comes the Fair Market Value.
